Timothy Abbott, bassoonist and contrabassoonist, currently resides in Ann Arbor, MI and actively performs across Southeast Michigan. He plays with the Adrian, Birmingham-Bloomfield, Flint, and Warren Symphonies, and is a frequent substitute with many other local orchestras, including the Ann Arbor and Oakland Symphonies. In addition to his performing career, Timothy is a dedicated private instructor of the bassoon with students from Ann Arbor and the surrounding areas.

Timothy completed his undergraduate studies at Indiana University in 2008 where he graduated with a Bachelors of Music in Bassoon Performance as well as a Bachelors of Science in Biology with a minor in Chemistry.

Jacqueline Wright holds a Master of Music degree in Flute Performance from the University of Michigan (2010) and a Master of Music degree in Orchestral Conducting from the University of Florida (2006), as well as Bachelors of Music degrees in Flute Performance and Music Education from the University of Rhode Island (2004). She has performed and conducted in national and international venues, including the multiple National Flute Association Annual Conferences, the Burgos (Spain) Chamber Music Festival and London Conducting Workshop. Jacqueline has performed in the summer flute schools of William Bennett and Trevor Wye and in masterclasses for flutists such as Denis Bouriakov, Alberto Almarza and Susan Milan.
